ABOUT THE CURRICULUM

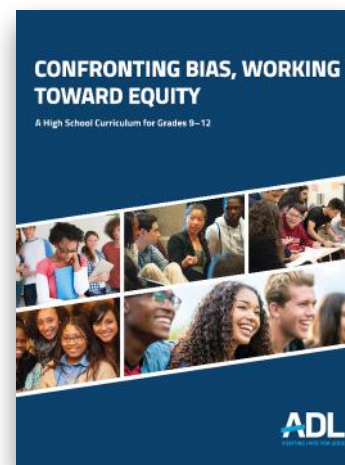
