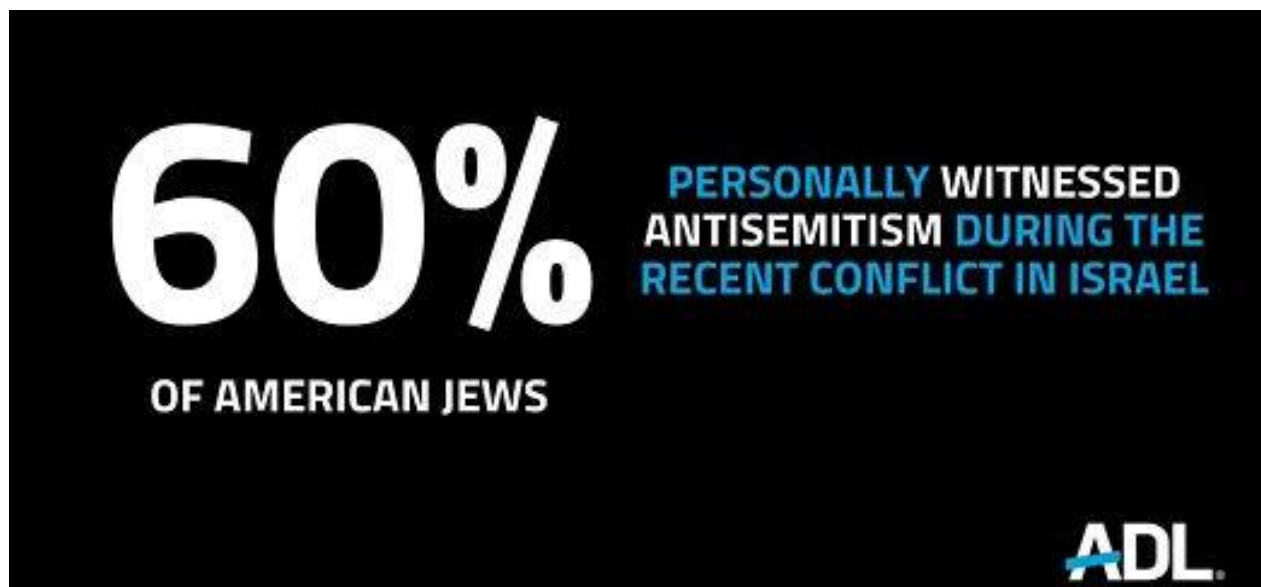
### **STOP HATE FOR PROFIT - EVALUATING PROGRESS**

One year ago, the **[Stop Hate for Profit \(SHFP\)](#)** coalition demanded Facebook address the prevalence of hate, racism, and misinformation on their platforms. SHFP garnered support from thousands of businesses that paused spending on Facebook and Instagram advertisements in July 2020.

Below are top highlights from ADL's one-year report:

- No platform has made significant structural changes.
- **Facebook made the least amount of progress toward meeting the SFHP coalition's demands.**
- Reddit has made the most progress among the platforms examined.

### **ADL SURVEY RESULTS**

Early data from ADL suggests antisemitic incidents have increased significantly, both online and offline, after the conflict between Israel and the Palestinians returned to the national spotlight.

ADL's latest survey indicates **American Jews have witnessed more antisemitic incidents**, are **concerned for their safety**, and **feel there is more leaders should be doing** to address this.
