2021 ONLINE ANTISEMITISM REPORT CARD

In recent years, American Jews have faced increased threats of violence and harassment both online and offline. According to ADL's annual Audit of Antisemitic Incidents, 2019 and 2020 were, respectively, the highest and third-highest years on record for cases of harassment, vandalism and assault against Jews in the United States since tracking began in 1979. Against this alarming backdrop, are tech platforms doing enough to combat antisemitism? To help evaluate this, ADL analyzed how well nine platforms addressed submitted reports of antisemitic content.
