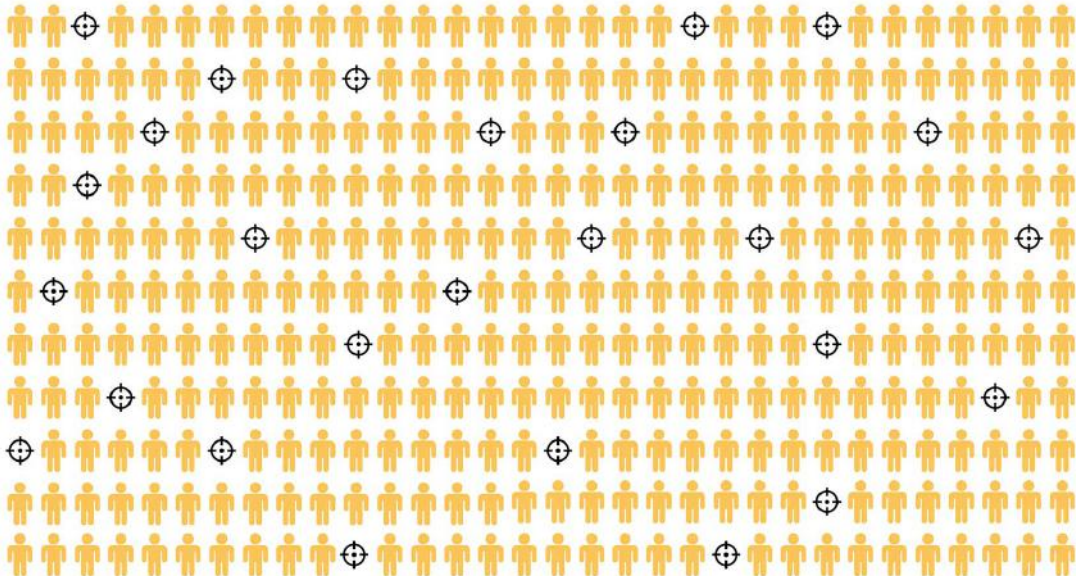

EXTREMISTS RAISED \$6.2M ON CROWDFUNDING WEBSITES

A new ADL report found that extremists are using online crowdfunding platforms, like GoFundMe, to raise more \$6.2 million in recent years for various nefarious causes. Crowdfunding campaigns also have been used to fund legal defenses for extremists accused of crimes.
