



WHITE SUPREMACIST PROPAGANDA REPORT

In 2023, for the second year in a row, ADL recorded its highest ever number of white supremacist propaganda incidents, with a total of 7,567 cases. This is a 12 percent increase from the 6,746 incidents in 2022.

This annual assessment is just one dataset that helps to quantify the hate marginalized communities face on a daily basis. The numbers in this assessment are subject to change as law enforcement and other stakeholders release information that could increase the total amount of propaganda incidents in individual states.

ATLAS (ANTISEMITISM TRENDS, LEARNING AND STATISTICS)

ADL's new ATLAS tool provides global antisemitism information and analysis. The data includes antisemitic incidents, antisemitic attitudes, information about government commitments and a variety of reports - all providing a comprehensive picture of the state of antisemitism worldwide.

AWARENESS TO ACTION: CHALLENGING ANTISEMITISM

On March 19th, ADL launched a new online learning experience, Awareness to Action: Challenging Antisemitism, tailored for middle and high school student groups. This comprehensive course aims to demystify antisemitism and equip students with the tools to combat bias. Divided into four modules, the course is freely available to schools, with each module designed to be completed in under 30 minutes. The initiative responds to a critical need, as antisemitic incidents have surged across the United States, including on college campuses and in K-12 schools.
